At the end the president of student, Mr Prashant and some other students also expressed their views on the teachings of Swami Vivekananda and he being the ideal role model for the youth of the country.





They also shared some great philosophies and sayings of Swami Vivekananda with students.








NATIONAL YOUTH DAY



The volunteers and other students watched the film and were really inspired.
















